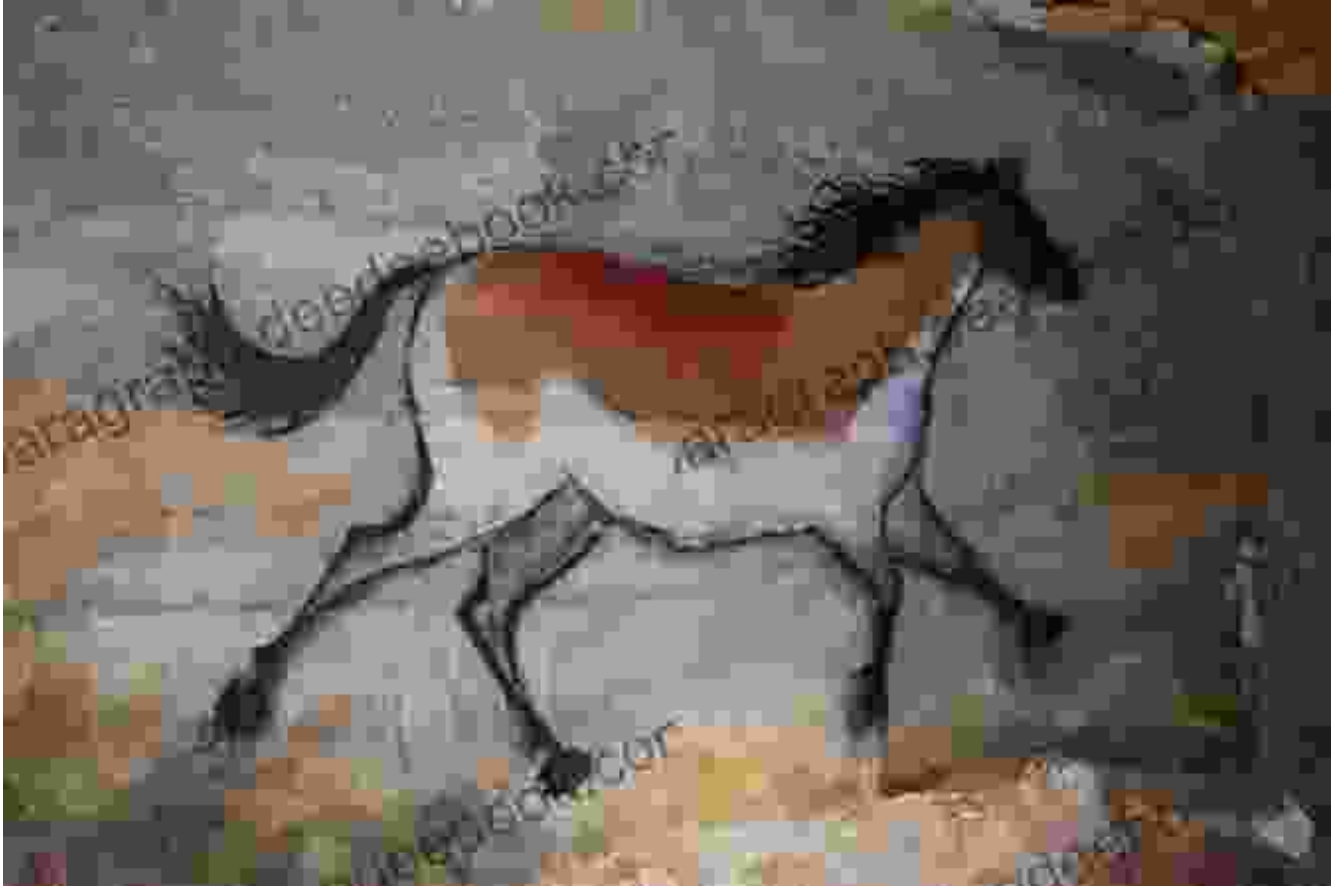
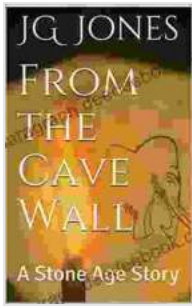


From the Cave Wall: A Journey Through the History of Art

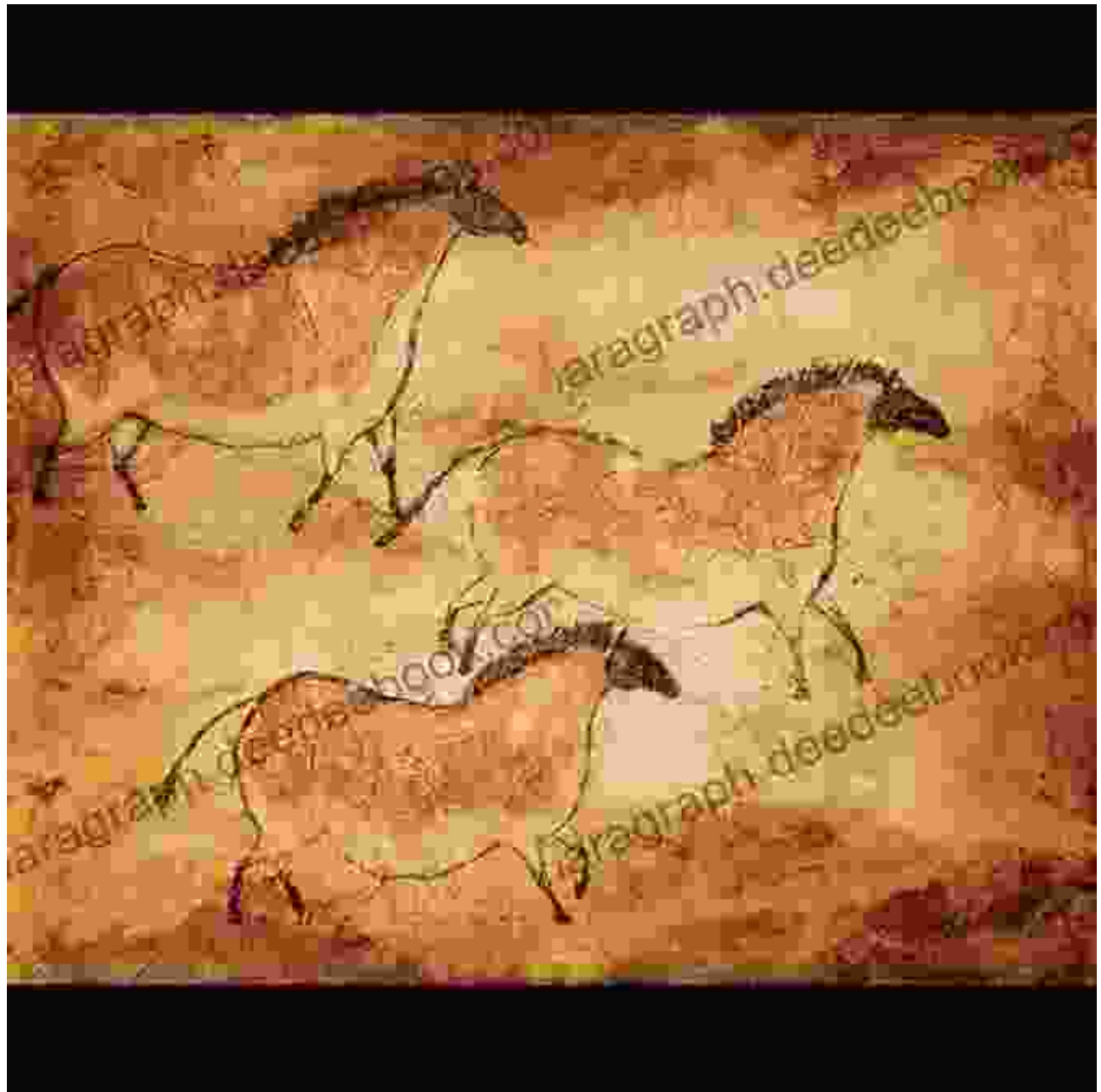

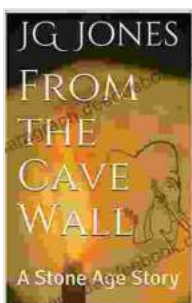

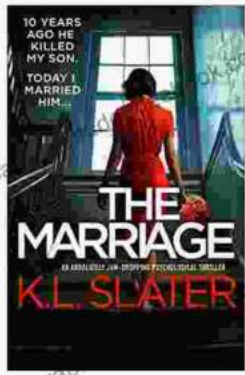
