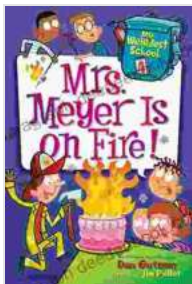


My Weirdest School: Mrs. Meyer Is On Fire

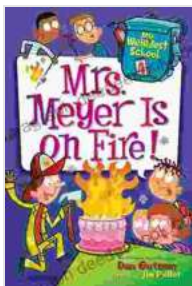

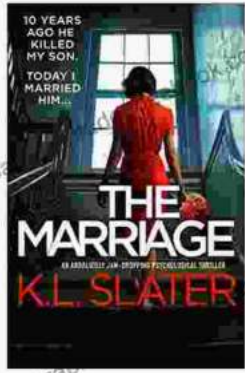
